



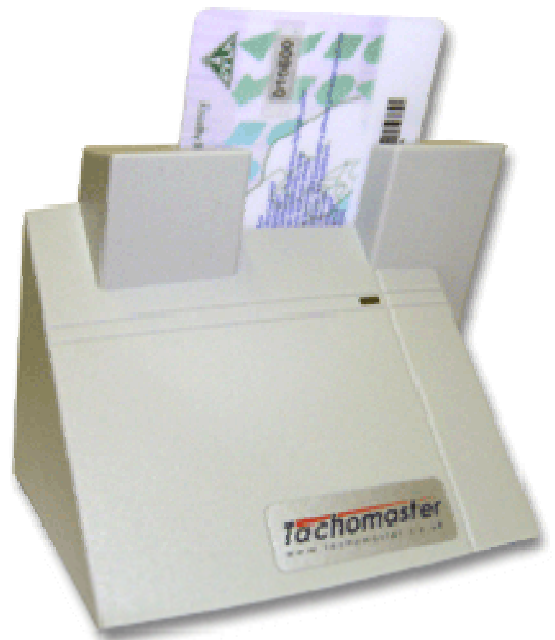

## ABBHEY OFFERS MEMBERS FREE 28-DAY TRIAL OF ITS VERSATILE TACHOGRAPH ANALYSIS SYSTEM

Fleet owners and owner-drivers who are facing the complexities of transition from analogue to digital tachographs, and who are Abbey fuelcard member organisations, are being offered the chance to try out a versatile new analysis system for 28 days free of charge. No other system is currently offering this try-before-buy facility and there is no obligation to retain it beyond the trial period.

Leading UK fuelcard provider, Abbey, say that the **Abbey Tachomaster** will immediately solve the transition problem, as well as save considerable time and worry. This is because Tachomaster system can read, store and analyse both digital cards and analogue charts, and, importantly, all drivers' tachograph information is automatically validated against the Road Transport Directive. For fleets going through a phased conversion to digital, it means there is no need to maintain two separate databases while they have some vehicles still fitted with analogue tachographs.





The Abbey Tachomaster system can read digital cards in under a minute. For analogue charts, members can choose how to upload them – either by using Abbey’s bureau service, or by self-processing using the

Tachomaster software. According to Abbey, one of the most significant benefits of the system is that it will automatically alert operators to any infringements immediately after the tachograph information is uploaded so that remedial action can be taken without any delay.

Tachomaster subscribers will also receive comprehensive reports in the format they prefer, and these can be printed out or displayed on-screen. They will include vehicle utilisation summaries, and analyses for management.

If members do decide to retain Tachomaster after the trial period ends, there will be a charge for use of the system from £1 per driver per week. This will entitle subscribers to the full analysis, monitoring and reporting services provided by Abbey.
